Artificial Intelligence in the Brazilian Judiciary and the +Acordo Platform

The seminar will discuss how Brazil is progressing in institutionalising AI in courts with a focus on +Acordo, an AI-enabled dispute resolution developed by the Rio de Janeiro Court of Justice. In its initial stage, +Acordo used AI algorithms to suggest settlement proposals based on data extracted from more than 50,000 legal cases, promoting speed and standardization in conciliatory solutions.

André Luiz Alves is Judge of the 1st Civil Court - Itabira/MG – Brazil and regular student on Master’s program at the National School for the Training and Professional Development of Magistrates in Brazil - ENFAM.
