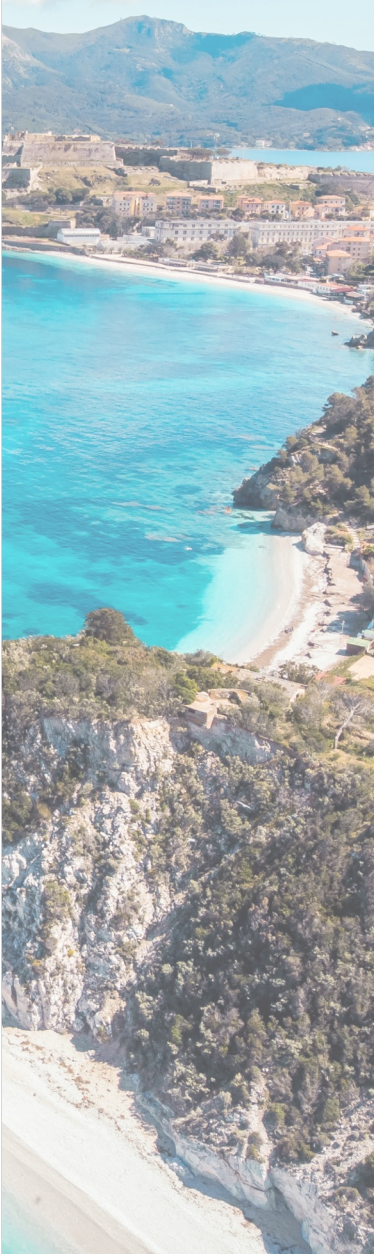


DCC-CR's strategic objectives



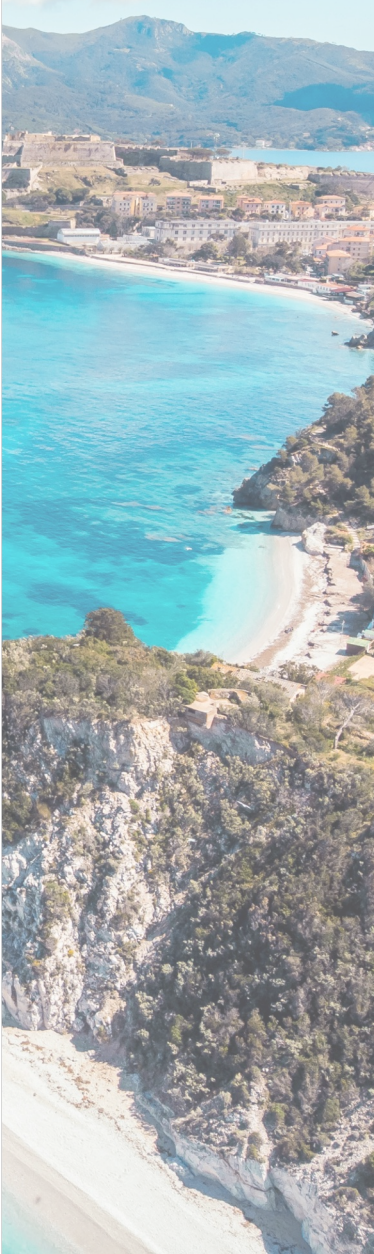
