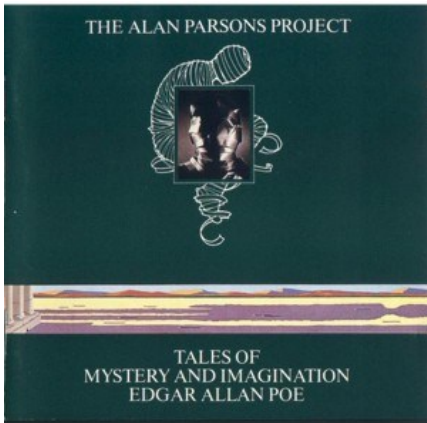

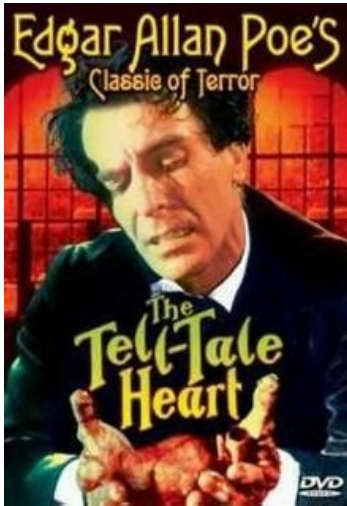

## **11. The Tell-Tale Heart - Classic Radio 1951**

The Tell-Tale Heart by Edgar Allen Poe. Produced by NBC Presents: Short Story. Produced and recorded in 1951, the episode never made it to air. It was preempted and never re-aired. Short Story only lasted one season and many of its episodes were preempted until it was eventually replaced. It is probably no coincidence that 1951 was the same year that NBC started it's first coast to coast television network.
